






How we support democracy

2019 highlights from our databases



Elections

63 countries had presidential or national legislative elections in 2019.

In total, **1,218,827,598** people voted in these elections.

The global average voter turnout was 64.66%.



Political Finance

66.7% of countries ban foreign donations to political parties.

27.8% of countries ban corporate donations to political parties.

In **60.1%** of countries, political finance reports from political parties and/or candidates are required to be made public.



Electoral systems

In **39.2%** of countries elections are held using Plurality/Majority systems.

In 38.7% of countries elections are held using Proportional Representation systems.

14.7% of countries elections are held using Mixed systems.

Electoral Management

In 63% of countries elections are administered by independent electoral management bodies.

In 20% of countries elections are run by governmental electoral management bodies.

14% of countries use the mixed model of electoral management.

DEMOCRACY IN ACTION



Voting system

25.5% of all countries do not allow out-of-country voting (OCV), and this is 1.5% increase compared to 2018. OCV was restricted in a number of countries, such as Afghanistan and Marshall Islands.

20% of countries across the globe use electronic voting in elections. Switzerland put on hold the use of e-voting in 2019 Federal Elections.

56% of countries across the globe process election results by electronic tabulation systems.

Voter register

In 56 countries (32%), Electoral management bodies use biometric technology for voter registration.

In 52% of countries voter register is compiled by electoral management bodies.

In **36%** of countries voter register is extracted from civil registry, and this is 4% increase compared to 2018.

10% of countries use combined method, and this is 4% decrease compared to 2018.

Member States

International IDEA's Member States are democracies and provide both political and financial support to the work of the organization.

Japan has observer status.
